6 IAU 50K WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Competition

IAU World 50K Championships have 4 competitions:

- A. Men's individual Competition
- **B.** Women's individual Competition
- C. Men's Team Competition
- D. Women's Team competition

<u>Eligibility</u>

The IAU 50K WC are only for the athletes and the team official entered by IAU Member Federations. Only athletes and teams officially registered by their National Federation will count for the Championships teams' result. Every Country can send **9 men and 9 women** with a maximum number of officials according to team number (1-6 athletes: 3 officials, 7-12 athletes: 6 officials, 13-18 athletes: 9 officials).

For the individual results, it will only rank the performances(km) of the athletes in each delegation. For the teams' results, only 6 per team, the delegation will be ranked according to the addition of the performances(km) of their 3 best athletes in the team. During the Award Ceremony, IAU medals will be given to 6 athletes and the team leader. Team leader must confirm the names of these 6 athletes who will be ranked in the team competition before the Technical Meeting (at the Outfit Meeting).

7 ENTRIES - PRELIMINARY (PEF) AND FINAL (FEF) ENTRY FORMS

Preliminary Entry Form

Each Federation must send the form provided by IAU. In order to book the accommodation, each Federation will send a list with numbers of athletes, officials, and other team member, and likely dates of travel and accommodation requirements

Final Entry Form

Each Federation must send the forms provided by IAU. With the final entry form, each Federation will send the **final list** with the names of the athletes, dates of birth, sex and curriculum vitae or personal bests, and inform the LOC about the travel itinerary details of the delegation members (arrival and departure times, flight No.), the requirement about accommodation (number of rooms, number of nights, number of meals) and other special note (vegetarian...) to be provided. Also, the LOC would like to collect the photo of each athlete for promotional use so please provide the athletes' photos when sending the FEF as well.

Please note that the travel and accommodation offer made by the LOC are conditional on the prompt return of the entry forms within the deadlines.

The PEF/FEF must be sent in digital format via email before the deadline.

WMA Entry

Athletes who are already entered in the IAU Championships as part of a national delegations and who wish to be eligible for placing in the WMA Championships must in addition also register on the website before midnight October 10, 2023 – 24:00 Indian Standard Time (GMT+5.30); and pay the extra entry fee USD\$100.

8 TRAVEL GRANTS AND THE USE OF WILDCARDS (rev)

Travel Grant information/receipts will be scheduled with the Delegations on the occasion of the Outfit Meeting. The allocated Travel Grant for the National Athletics Federations for this MIAUC will be announced nearer the time but will be of the order of the following example:

*Flying times are calculated point to point and may not reflect the actual time taken.

Team-Grant are paid for maximum one male and one female team, (minimum 3 runners/team). Individual-Grant are paid for maximum 3 men and 3 women per country. All these grants are cumulative.

The Travel Grant will only be paid by <u>Bank Transfer</u> after the event.

The Provisional Travel Grant (PTG) information will be sent by email to the contact named in the PEF two weeks before the race. The provisional travel grant will need to be signed with bank details confirmed and returned to <u>robert.boyce@iau-ultramarathon.org</u> prior to the championships. At the start of the race there will be a check of the athletes who have started. If athletes who are on the PTG information, do not start the amount of TG will be changed. Final payment amounts will be made after the event from confirmed athletes who started.

Use of Wildcards

WILDCARDS mean that a runner with only a C level (or less) may be upgraded to a B-level for that particular MIAU competition. At every MIAUC a maximum of 2 wildcards (one man and one women) will be given automatically.

9 ACCREDITATION

Throughout the event, the central office of the LOC will be located at the Green Park Hotel, Hyderabad, the accreditation procedure will also be organized there. The accreditation service hours depend on the arrival data of the teams.

Accreditation badges will be prepared in advance of the event, based on the information provided by the Member Federation in the FEF.

No changes will be accepted after the final entry deadline.

Accreditation badges will be handed out on the team's arrival.

Team Leaders WhatsApp Groups

A WhatsApp group including all Member Federations' team leaders will be created, to address instant messages and announcements. Major information of interest for all will be communicated to the teams by the organizing committee via this group.



10 SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The LOC of IAU 50K World Championship has set out to establish a new model for the world championship, pledging to deliver this more responsible and sustainable event.

The LoC will pledge minimal use of paper and plastic and responsible disposal of event wastage. Participants are requested to use re-usable containers/bottles during the race.

12 Travel & TRANSPORTATION

Transfers From and To Airport

Travel to and from the airport will be arranged at no extra cost for those staying at the official accommodation for the race and the booking will be made while submitting the FEF. Teams should meet the LOC staff who will be waiting for them at the arrival area of the airport. The return transportation to airport after race will be arranged about 3 hours before the airplane takes off. The transportation schedule will be given out after arrival.

Local Transportation

The LOC will organize the transportation for the athletes staying in the official accommodation, from and to the race venue for the competition on the race day: 2-3 hours before start, and 1-1.5 hours after finish. The final schedule will be announced at the technical meeting.

During the race, there will be a shuttle service between the venue and the accommodation.

For any other local travel participants can use a local taxi that can be arranged by LoC on request. The charges for this will be borne by participants directly.

15 IMPORTANT PROGRAM INFORMATION

Outfit Meeting & Travel Grant Confirmation

This meeting is mandatory for all delegations. Team leaders need to present their national uniforms for inspection, and to confirm the athletes who are competing and be ranked. The bibs and the chips will be distributed at the meeting. There are 4 bib numbers and 2 systems of timing chips provided. The first timing chip is on the back of bib number tags. The second chip should be tied on the shoe or strap to the ankle, and the team leader is responsible for collecting the chips from athletes after the race and returning as a team at the certificate pick-up area.

Technical Meeting

Saturday afternoon, November 4 between 14:00-15:00, Green Park Hotel.

The Meeting will be conducted in English. Each Team may be represented by a maximum of two people. Any inquiries concerning the technical conduct of the Championships must be made in English to the LOC via following link latest by 09:00 on the day of the meeting. These questions will be answered at the meeting.

Opening Ceremony & Welcome Dinner

The Meeting point for all teams is at 17.30 at the Green Park Hotel Lobby. We ask you to be on time as we have a tight protocol for the opening ceremony. 17 MEDICAL & INSURANCE

Physiotherapy Services

Physiotherapists will be at the competition venue during the race. There will be an open area at the venue for medical treatments. The service time will be announced on site.

Medical

The safety and welfare of competitors is of paramount importance to the Medical Team. In accordance with rule 53.1 of the WA Competition Rules, each Federation agrees to submit the following information surrounding its runners:

- a. Any medical history and/or pathology in particular those which may increase their risk during exercise.
- b. The regular use of treatments and medicines in the 15 days leading up to the race.
- c. All requests form of use of medicines subject to a Therapeutic Usage Exemption (TUE).
- d. Accept to answer any request the Medical Team may make based on the information submitted in order to discuss the runner's ability or not to participate in the competition.
- e. Accept that, under rule 144 of the WA Competition Rules, the Medical Team decision on participation before or during the race is final.
- f. Any RTPCR/Vaccination Report will be as stipulated by the local government.

Insurance

The LOC provide public liability insurance and medical cover for the race on site. Participating Member Federation are responsible for taking out their own insurance to cover the risk of illness or injury of any member of their team when travelling to and from 2023 IAU 50KM Championships and during the event itself. Please take the necessary steps to fulfil these requirements well in advance.

A person who registers on the website or submits the entry form with the team means that he/she agrees and consents to accept medical treatment from the LOC or their medical personnel in the event that he/she is injured or otherwise becomes ill or incapacitated during the Championships. In the event of any emergency medical treatment or services provided to the person requiring the payment of fees, he/she agrees to pay these fees upon request.

Doping Controls

The Anti-Doping Regulations of the World Anti-Doping Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency will be applied. Post-competition doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WA Rules and by the India's National Anti-Doping Association (NADA).

Teams who need a doping control (at their cost about USD\$) for the ratification of a national record have to indicate it in the FEF.

Team leaders might like to keep a copy of athletes' passport for identification if asked by an official or if the athlete of the team is chosen for a doping test.



18 OPEN RACE

In addition to the athletes of the IAU Championships, there will be a limited number of runners allowed to take part in the competition. Runners wishing to enter should.

- a. register by sending email to ultrarunning@nebsports.in.
- b. pays an entry fee of USD\$.

The LOC will finalise and announced the list of the accepted participants.

Open Race - Registration Pack Distribution

To proceed with the distribution procedure, open race participants please present the passport. The registration pack will include a total of 4 bib numbers for each athlete, pins, timing IC chip, and other information and souvenir the LOC will provide.

There will be 2 systems of timing chips provided. The first timing chip is on the back of bib number tags. The second chip should be tied on the shoe or strap to the ankle, and this chip should be returned after the race at the certificate pick-up area with a deposit refunded.

19 HOST INFORMATION

INDIA ON THE WORLD MAP

India is the world's largest democracy known for its diverse culture and blend of spirituality and technology. Indian movies, music, and spiritual teachings are now getting quite popular across the globe.



It is the <u>seventh-largest</u> country by area, the <u>most populous</u> country in the world.

Though the country's population remains largely rural, India has three of the most populous and <u>cosmopolitan</u> cities in the world—<u>Mumbai</u> (Bombay), <u>Kolkata</u> (Calcutta), and <u>Delhi</u>. Three other cities—<u>Bengaluru</u> (Bangalore), <u>Chennai</u> (Madras), and <u>Hyderabad</u>—are among the world's fastest-growing high-technology centres, and most of the world's major information technology and software companies now have offices in India.

HYDERABAD

Hyderabad is the capital and largest city of the Indian state of Telangana. It occupies 650 km2 (250 sq mi) on the Deccan Plateau along the banks of the Musi River, in the northern part of Southern India. With an average altitude of 542 m (1,778 ft), much of Hyderabad is situated on hilly terrain around artificial lakes, including the Hussain Sagar lake, predating the city's founding, in the north of the city centre. According to the 2011 Census of India, Hyderabad is the fourth-most
