IAU Membership Constitution Amendment to Rule 7.

EC is proposing an amendment to the constitution to be able to align IAU membership for some country federations more in line with that for the IAAF.

Current Constitution.

“Article 7 : Membership

7.1

There can be only one IAU Member per country

7.2

The IAAF Member in any country shall be eligible and take precedence for IAU Membership;

OR, in the absence of the IAAF Member,
the National Ultrarunning Association (NUA) recognised by the IAAF Member
and authorised by the IAAF Member to be the IAU Member.”

The IAU Executive Committee is proposing the following wording change to 7.1
There are no consequential amendments to be made elsewhere in the
Constitution. The amended words are in bold.

Executive Council recommendation - Constitution Amendment to Article 7.1. in bold.

7.1 Normally there can only be one IAU Member per country **however there can be more than one IAU Member per country if and only if these Members are all separate IAAF Members.**
